



Manual Handling Task Appraisal and Risk Assessment

This course is designed to provide Line Supervisors/Managers with experience of conducting practical assessments within their own working environment. The course covers the legal requirements and how to conduct risk assessments and draw up safe systems of work to avoid operator injury in the short or long term.

COURSE CONTENT

THE INCIDENCE OF MANUAL HANDLING PROBLEMS/INJURIES

The first half of this course covers practical training/advice on the risks involved and safe methods to avoid injury when manual handling.

TECHNIQUES OF APPRAISAL/ASSESSMENT

The second half teaches line managers/supervisors how to conduct risk assessments and ensure safe systems of work for staff under their supervision.

- Practical Assessments within the work area
- Recording and review procedure of assessments
